Our home repair program brings volunteers from service groups, businesses, congregations, and community agencies together to help low-income homeowners who are challenged by age, disability, or circumstance.

“A Brush With Kindness” brings resources, volunteers, and homeowners together to paint, landscape, replace windows and doors, repair plumbing and electrical problems, replace stoves and refrigerators, install weather-stripping and low-flow shower heads, repair or replace floors, provide general clean-up, and much more. Homeowners repay the costs of materials; or cost is deferred and paid at the refinance or sale of the home. Homeowners and family members, if they are able, work side by side with volunteers to complete the restoration of their home .

“A Brush With Kindness” is a meaningful way to serve others. Individuals and groups can bring hope to someone who needs help maintaining their home. Teams range from 6-20 volunteers and work with Habitat supervisors. The scope of the work to be performed on each house is determined by the “A Brush With Kindness” coordinator and the homeowner.
